Pastoral Letter of Mar Jacob Angadiath

Lent, March 3, 2011

Pastoral Letter No. 11/2011



By the grace of God, I, Your Servant, Mar Jacob Angadiath, Bishop of St. Thomas Syro-Malabar Catholic Diocese of Chicago and Permanent Apostolic Visitor to Canada, send this greeting and message to all the priests, men and women religious, and my beloved people of God, living in the USA and Canada.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the gospel of God: "This is the time of fulfillment. The Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel". (Mk 1:14-15)

This is the inaugural message of Jesus. His invitation is extended to everyone realizing the nearness of God's Kingdom, we are called to repent and believe in the gospel. The best liturgical season to reflect and renew our life is the period of Lent. These seven weeks of intense prayer, penance and charity lead us to the great feast of resurrection, the Easter.

This year St. Thomas Syro-Malabar Catholic Diocese of Chicago is completing ten years. This is a time to reflect together how to grow in the future, based on our experience of the past. As we intensify our Christian Spirit during Lent, let us keep in mind the theme of this special year of 10th anniversary of our diocese: "To know, to love and to build our Church." As we pray in our Syro-Malabar Holy Qurbana. "Let us please God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit through our fasting, prayer and repentance." Since Church is the continuation of Christ here on earth let us promote the growth of the Church through our knowl-

edge and love of the Church, and through personal commitment to build our Church. Yes, let us renew our commitment to know more, love well and build our Church stronger during this 10th anniversary occasion.

To Know Our Church: There are different aspects in the process of knowing the Church. The nature, the structure, the purpose, and our role in the Church are very important in this dimension of knowing the Church. The best method of knowing our Church will be the study of The Constitution on the Church, given by Second Vatican Council. Each chapter is very specially and specifically drafted and arranged: 1. The Mystery of the Church; 2. The People of God; 3. The Church is Hierarchical; 4. The Laity; 5. The Call to Holiness; 6. Religious; 7. The Pilgrim Church; and 8. Our Lady. Here we see the nature and structure of One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church.

We are members of this One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church as we are members of the Syro-Malabar Church. Our Syro-Malabar Church is one of the twenty-two particular Churches whose communion makes the Catholic Church. To know our Syro-Malabar Church, we need to study the history of Christianity in India and especially in South India. This study of our Church has to cover the spirituality, theology, liturgy and canonical discipline of our Church. This anniversary moment will be a golden occasion to make a little effort to know better who we are.

As Christ had divine and human natures, the Church also has two phases, divine and human. The divine elements, such as the Bible, Sacraments, Hierarchy, and dogma are unchangeable; the human elements, such as way of worship, mode of celebration of Sacraments, liturgical vestments and administrative rules are changeable. A clear picture of this distinction is very important in the practice of our faith. Many issues are developed due to the lack of knowledge of this reality. Let us remember that we are an Apostolic Church with a rich heritage.

During this period of Lent let us make an effort at least to read the particular document of Vatican II, The Constitution on the Church. Also let us look into the brief history of St. Thomas Christians of India.

To Love Our Church: As we know our Church, naturally we are inclined to love our Church. The love for our Church is cherished through our prayer, Bible reading and reflection, frequent reception of the

വികാരിയുടെ സന്ദേശം

സ്വന്തം കുരിശുമെടുത്ത് ക്രൂശിതന്റെ പിന്നാലെ

എന്റെ പ്രിയ സഹോദരങ്ങളേ,

വലിയ നോമ്പുകാലത്ത് കത്തോലിക്കർ പ്രത്യേക പ്രാധാന്യം നൽകി ആചരിക്കുന്ന ഭക്തകൃത്യമാണ് സ്തീവാപാമ എന്നുകൂടി അറിയപ്പെടുന്ന കുരിശിന്റെ വഴി. വെള്ളിയാഴ്ചകളിൽ ഈ അനുഷ്ഠാനത്തിന് കൂടുതൽ പ്രസക്തിയുണ്ടാകുന്നത് ക്രിസ്തുവിന്റെ കുരിശു മരണം വെള്ളിയാഴ്ച ആയിരുന്നതിനാലാണ്.

സേക്രഡ് ഹാർട്ടിലേതു കൂടാതെ, ഈ വർഷം സെന്റ് മേരീസിലും വെള്ളിയാഴ്ചകളിൽ കുർബാനയെ തുടർന്ന് കുരിശിന്റെ വഴി ആചരിക്കുന്നതാണ്. സ്തീവാപാമയുടെ ചരിത്ര പശ്ചാത്തലവും അർത്ഥവും പ്രസക്തിയും അനുസ്മരിക്കുന്നത് ഈ അവസരത്തിൽ പ്രസക്തമാണല്ലോ.

പീലാത്തോസിന്റെ അരമന മുതൽ കുരിശുചുമന്ന് ഈശോ നടത്തിയ ഏറെ അപമാനകരവും, അതിലുപരി വേദനാജനകവുമായ യാത്ര അനുസ്മരിച്ച് അതേ പാതയിലൂടെ പ്രാർത്ഥനാപൂർവ്വം തീർത്ഥാടനം നടത്തുവാൻ ആദിമ നൂറ്റാണ്ടുമുതൽ ക്രൈസ്തവർ ശ്രമിച്ചിരുന്നു. എന്നാൽ ദുരൂഹമായും സാങ്കേതിക പ്രശ്നങ്ങളും മൂലം പലപ്പോഴും ജറുസലേമിൽത്തന്നെ അതു നടത്തുക സാധ്യമായിരുന്നില്ല. അതിനാൽ കുരിശുമരണത്തിന് വിധിക്കുന്നതു മുതൽ കല്ലറയിൽ സംസ്കരിക്കുന്നതുവരെയുള്ള പ്രധാന സംഭവങ്ങൾ ഉൾപ്പെടുത്തി, തങ്ങൾക്കു സമീപസ്ഥമായ പ്രദേശങ്ങളിൽ വിശ്വാസികൾ കുരിശിന്റെ പാതകൾ കൃത്രിമമായി തീർത്തു. ക്രിസ്തു സഞ്ചരിച്ച യഥാർത്ഥ പാതവഴിയല്ലെങ്കിലും, ക്രിസ്തുവിന്റെ പീഡാസഹനത്തിന്റെ അനുസ്മരണ പുതുക്കി സ്വന്തം കുരിശുകൾ അവിടുത്തെ കുരിശിനോടു ചേർത്തു സമർപ്പിക്കുവാൻ വിശ്വാസികൾക്ക് ഇതുവഴി സാധിച്ചു.

കുരിശിന്റെ വഴിയ്ക്കു വിവിധ ഘട്ടങ്ങൾ ചിട്ടപ്പെടുത്തി ലോകമാസകലം പ്രചരിപ്പിച്ചത് വിശുദ്ധ ഫ്രാൻസിസ് അസ്സീസിയാണ്. വിശുദ്ധ നാടുകളിലെ പ്രധാന ക്രൈസ്തവ കേന്ദ്രങ്ങളുടെ സംരക്ഷണച്ചുമതല 1342ൽ ഫ്രാൻസിസ്കൻ സന്യാസികൾക്കു പരിശുദ്ധ സിംഹാസനം നൽകി. അതിന് ശേഷമാണ് വിശുദ്ധ നാടുകളിലും മറ്റു സ്ഥലങ്ങളിലും കുരിശിന്റെ വഴി പ്രചരപ്രചാരത്തിലായത്.

പതിനഞ്ചും പതിനാറും നൂറ്റാണ്ടുകളിൽ ഫ്രാൻസിസ്കൻ സന്യാസികൾ യൂറോപ്പിലെ വിവിധ പ്രദേശങ്ങളിൽ ഇറങ്ങിയ സ്ഥലങ്ങളിൽ കുരിശിന്റെ വഴിയുടെ വിവിധ ചിത്രങ്ങൾ ആലേഖനം ചെയ്തു ശൈലികൾ സ്ഥാപിച്ചു. 1686ൽ പതിനൊന്നാം

ഇന്നസെന്റ് മാർപാപ്പാ ഫ്രാൻസിസ്കൻ സഭക്കാരുടെ പള്ളിയ്ക്കു കത്തും സ്തീവാപാമയുടെ ചിത്രങ്ങൾ സ്ഥാപിക്കുവാൻ അനുവാദം നൽകി. 1731ൽ ക്ലൈമെന്റ് പത്രോസാമൻ മാർപാപ്പാ എല്ലാ പള്ളികളിലും അതു സ്ഥാപിക്കുവാൻ അനുവദിച്ചു. എന്നാൽ അത് സ്ഥാപിക്കേണ്ടിയിരുന്നത് പ്രാദേശിക മെത്രാന്റെ അനുവാദത്തോടെ ഫ്രാൻസിസ്കൻ വൈദികരായിരുന്നു. 1857ൽ ഇംഗ്ലണ്ടിലും 1862ൽ ലോകം മുഴുവനിലും ഫ്രാൻസിസ്കൻ സഭക്കാരുടെ സഹായമില്ലാതെ കുരിശിന്റെ വഴിയുടെ ചിത്രങ്ങൾ പള്ളികളിൽ സ്ഥാപിക്കുവാൻ അനുവാദം നൽകി.

ക്രൂശിതന്റെ സഹനത്തിന്റെയും മരണത്തിന്റെയും അനുസ്മരണ നവീകരിച്ച് ആത്മീയ തീർത്ഥാടനം നടത്തുവാൻ നാം കുരിശിന്റെ വഴി കൊണ്ട് ഉദ്ദേശിച്ചിട്ടുള്ളത്. നിതിമാനം നിഷ്കളങ്കനായ ഈശോ സഹനത്തിലൂടെ മറ്റുള്ളവർക്കുവേണ്ടി ആത്മത്യാഗം ചെയ്തതുപോലെ നമ്മുടെ അനുദിന ജീവിതത്തിന്റെ കുരിശുകളെ സമചിത്തതയോടെ ഏറ്റെടുക്കുവാനും സഹനത്തിലൂടെയും ത്യാഗത്തിലൂടെയും മറ്റുള്ളവരെ ആശ്വസിപ്പിക്കുവാനും രക്ഷിക്കുവാനും അതിലൂടെ നിത്യജീവിതത്തിലേയ്ക്കു നടന്നടുക്കുവാനും സ്തീവാപാമ നമുക്കു പ്രചോദനം നൽകുന്നു.

നമുക്കു സ്വന്തമായി ദൈവാലയങ്ങൾ ഉണ്ടായതുകൊണ്ടാണ് ഇന്നു നാം ആഗ്രഹിക്കുന്നവിധം വെള്ളിയാഴ്ചകളിൽ നമ്മുടെ തന്നെ പള്ളികളിൽ തനതായ രീതിയിൽ ഭക്തിനിർഭരമായി ഈ തിരുക്കർമ്മം അനുഷ്ഠിക്കുവാൻ കഴിയുന്നത്. ആ വലിയ ദൈവിക കൃപയ്ക്കു നന്ദിയർപ്പിച്ചുകൊണ്ട് ഈ അവസരം നമുക്കു പരമാവധി പ്രയോജനപ്പെടുത്താം. ഒപ്പം നമ്മുടെ കുട്ടികളെയും യുവതീയുവാക്കളെയും ഇതിൽ പങ്കുകാരാക്കാം.

Sacraments, regular attendance at Holy Qurbana, and sharing of our talents and treasures with our brothers and sisters. The love for the Church is enhanced through the teachings of the Fathers of the Church, Papal Encyclicals, and Church teachings.

A rich source for the love of the Church is our Liturgy. Liturgy includes the Holy Qurbana, celebration of all Sacraments and Liturgy of the Hours. All our liturgical feasts are very rich since their expressions of prayers are biblical, patristic and spiritual. Just for example: All the Eastern Catholic Churches have the beautiful prayer of "Trisagion", in which God is called, "Holy God, Mighty God and Immortal God" (സർവ്വശക്തനും...). The "Holy, Holy, Holy," is taken from Isaiah 6:3 and Revelation 4:8. The Hymn of Resurrection, " Lord of all..." is unique to the Chaldean and Syro-Malabar Holy Qurbana. The more we love our Church, the more we enjoy our liturgy and then what we pray and what we believe will be translated into our daily life. The love for our Church should transform us into missionaries of our Church.

During this Lent, let us pay special attention to participate in our liturgical celebration actively, consciously, and fruitfully. As we are invited to repent, let us be sorry for our sins and approach the sacrament of Confession to get reconciled with God, with our neighbor, and ourselves.

To Build Our Church: This expression is not primarily limited to the construction of a church; it means a lot more. Church is not the building where we gather to worship; we are the Church. The building becomes important because we the living temples of the Holy Spirit assemble there to worship God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. If God is not in us, the Church becomes empty. It is the assembly of the people of God that makes the living and active Church. Jesus assured us His presence in the assembly of the faithful, " Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them". (Mt 18:20)

The model of the Church is the early Christian Community. It is summarized in one sentence: "They devoted themselves to the teachings of the Apostles, and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers." (Acts 2:42) Basic principles of Christian living and building the Church are given here: 1. Teaching of the Apostles – Bible; 2. communal life – sharing; 3. Breaking of the bread - Holy Eucharist; and 4. Prayers-common and personal. All these four elements are needed in followers of Christ, as individual believers, as family, as parish, as diocese, and as Church.

During Lent, as part of the 10th anniversary observance of our diocese, let us examine ourselves, how far we are contributing in building our Church, our family, parish, and


diocese. God has blessed us with manifold gifts. These gifts are given to us to build the Church. Let us become the living temple of the Holy Spirit. Let us make our family a holy family. Let us build our parish after the model of the early Christian Community. Let us promote the growth of our diocese through our prayers, sharing and caring for one another.

Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God is the model for a believer. Let us seek her intercession and protection for our family, parish and diocese. Let the Christ experience of St. Thomas the Apostle, our father in faith and patron of our diocese, inspire us to have similar Christ encounter. May the prayers of St. Alphonsa assist us to lead a holy life.


