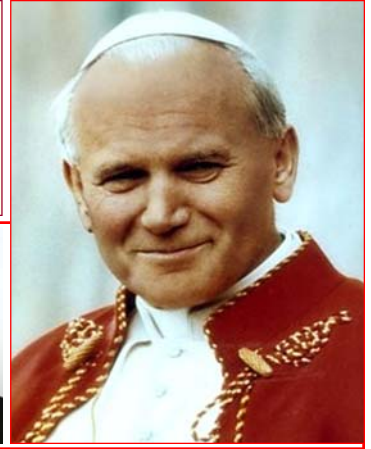

## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

### *The Reaffirmed motto: "IN GOD WE TRUST"*

My dear Knanaya Sisters and Brothers:

On the last All Saints Day, the House of Representatives in Washington D.C. reaffirmed the official motto of the United States of America, "In God We Trust." This national motto is displayed above the House Speaker's rostrum, imprinted on the U.S. coins since 1864, and on U.S. paper currency since 1957. This motto was adopted as the official motto of the nation in 1956 and is also the motto of the U.S. state of Florida. The Republic of Nicaragua has the same motto in Spanish, "En Dios Confamos."

Salmon P. Chase, the U.S. Treasury Secretary under President Abraham Lincoln first adapted this phrase. His belief was that no "nation can be strong except in the strength of God, or safe except in His defense." He wanted to declare this trust in God on the national coins.

Same phrase was adapted later in the U.S. national anthem and in the Pledge of Allegiance. In 1956, the phrase was legally adopted as the United States' national motto by the law passed by the 84th United States Congress. (Public Law 84-851).

Later, there were controversies and lawsuits against displaying this motto in public and including it in the Pledge of Allegiance arguing that it was against the Separation of Church and State by the First Amendment. However, it is now reaffirmed by the house that passed the resolution with 396 – 9 votes.

Besides reaffirming the motto, the house encourages it's display in all public schools and buildings. This is not the victory of religion or any particular sect of believers because God is common to all religious and spiritual persons.

My question then is, if the state acknowledges the trust in God in public, why cannot our churches, other institutions and houses also display the same? I think we should make the imprint of this motto available for purchase in our agape store to display in our houses and other build-

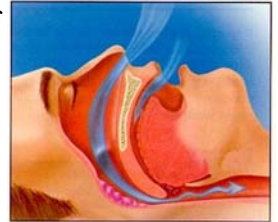
ings and on the bumpers of our cars.

Besides displaying the motto in public, let us ask ourselves: "In whom do we trust?" Many of us give the impression that we trust in money, insurance, job or family than God. If that is the case, we need to change our focus back to God who only can secure us an everlasting life of joy and peace.

## YOUTH CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

served. If such a truth is publicly disputed or distorted, the Church is called upon to clarify again "what has always and everywhere been believed by all".

### Q12. How can we tell what belongs to the true faith?

**A12. We find the true faith in Sacred Scripture and in the living Tradition of the Church.**

*The → NEW TESTAMENT developed out of the faith of the Church. Scripture and Tradition belong together. Handing on the faith does not occur primarily through documents. In the early Church it was said that Sacred Scripture was "written on the heart of the Church rather than on parchment". The disciples and the → APOSTLES experienced their new life above all through a living fellowship with Jesus. The early Church invited people into this fellowship, which continued in a different way after the Resurrection. The first Christians held fast "to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers". They were united with one another and yet had room for others. This is part of our faith to this day: Christians invite other individuals to come to know a fellowship with God that has been preserved unaltered since the times of the apostles in Catholic Church.*

### Q13. Can the church err in questions of faith?

**A13. The faithful as a whole cannot err in faith, because Jesus promised his disciples that he would send them the Spirit of truth and keep them in the truth.**

*Just as the disciples believed in Jesus with their whole heart, a Christian can rely completely on the Church when he asks about the way to life. Since Jesus Christ himself gave his apostles the commission to teach, the church has a teaching authority and must not remain silent. Although individual members of the Church can err and even make serious mistakes, the Church as a whole can never fall away from God's truth. The Church carries through the ages a living truth that is greater than herself. We speak about a depositum fidei, a deposit of faith that is to be pre-*

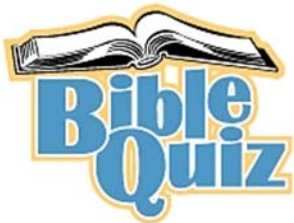
